

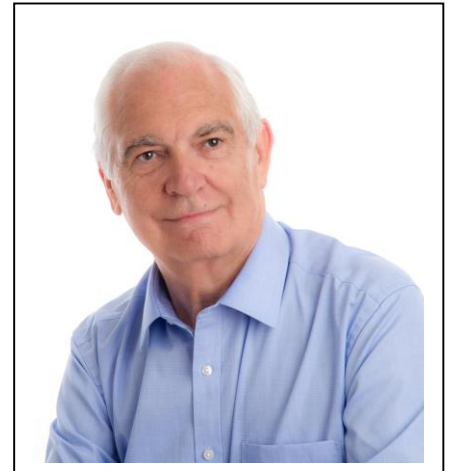

Experience

David is a Chartered Civil Engineer, Surveyor and accredited Mediator/Adjudicator with a total of 56 years' construction experience in the U.K., Europe, Africa, Middle East and Asia much of which either spent on Site or with works associated with Site works. David has considerable experience in design, supervision and management of civil engineering works, in particular roads, tunnels, waste water treatment plants, hydroelectric schemes, landfills, railways and bridges. His specialisms include project and contract management, the preparation of cost estimates and fee agreements, financial control, planning, and procurement (including EU procurement regulations & procedures). Also extensive experience in prequalification procedures, the preparation of many different types of contracts, tender procedure, tender assessment, contract administration, the

avoidance of disputes and the resolution of disputes by mediation, conciliation, expert determination and adjudication. Lecturer and author of technical papers on contracts, project management, dispute avoidance and resolution.

In April 2006, following 30 years' employment with Ove Arup & Partners, David established David Loosemore Limited providing Contract and Dispute Management services to practitioners in the construction industry for the avoidance and resolution of disputes, construction claims, procurement of contracts, contract administration, project management and control procedures. David also provides training/tutoring as a Senior Consultant to European Construction Ventures Ltd on FIDIC and other contracts, project management, dispute avoidance and resolution. Apart from various ongoing adjudication commissions in the UK (i.e. acting as Adjudicator and/or as advisor to parties in adjudication), David has current Dispute Adjudication Board (DAB) assignments in Sri Lanka, Uganda and Ghana and has had previous assignments in Georgia, Serbia, Greece, Albania, Liberia, Mozambique, Romania, Bulgaria, Moldova, Azerbaijan, Oman, France, Lesotho, Tanzania, Armenia, Estonia and Jordan.

Responsibilities included study of route options, safeguarding the route, outline design, consultation, support and assistance to the Department of Transport, as promoters of the Channel Tunnel Rail Link Bill, in the Parliamentary proceedings of both a House of Commons and a House of Lords Select Committee, during the petitioning process.

Following the passing of the Hybrid Bill, David was assigned as contracts specialist to the central procurement team of Rail Link Engineering (RLE), an integrated consortium, comprising Arup, Bechtel, Halcrow and Systra, providing all the engineering and associated professional services required for the project management, design, construction management, commissioning and start-up of the £3bn Channel Tunnel Rail Link.
